Point of order.	Object to procedure.	Yes	Chair
Point of personal privilege.	Complain about noise, room temp, etc...	Yes	Chair
Point of inquiry.	Request information from the Chair.	Yes	Chair
Point of information.	Question speaker through Chair.	No	Chair
Point of commentary.	Demonstrate an opinion or point of view to another delegate through the Chair.	No	Chair
Motion to start the speaker's list/Motion to set the agenda for the speaker's list.	Start or begin with the Position Paper Reading with a (number) of minutes, questions and commentaries.	No	Chair
Yield my time to the delegate of...	Give remaining time to another delegate.	No	Speaker
Yield my time to questions.	Uses extra time for additional questions.	No	Speaker
Yield my time to the chair.	Eliminates the time remaining.	No	Speaker
Second the motion.	Used to show support for the motion and grants you the floor.	No	Chair
Motion to close the speaker's list.	Close the speaker's list so no more delegates may be added.	No	Majority Vote



Motion for moderated debate for (Number) of minutes.	Debate among countries with the assistance of the moderator.	No	Majority Vote
Motion to close the moderated debate.	End or stop the moderated debate.	No	Majority Vote
Motion to split the house.	Split the committee into two possible resolution papers; the papers will be voted later on.	No	Majority Vote
Motion to open unmoderated debate for (Number) of minutes.	Start and open forum so delegates may start drafting a resolution paper.	No	Majority Vote
Motion to close unmoderated debate.	Stop the unmoderated debate and all drafting.	No	Majority Vote
Motion to close/adjourn the session.	Formally close any session.	No	Majority Vote
